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An estimated 500,000 dog bites occur annually in Canada. Ontario Humane Society estimates 1 bite per hour. Most shockingly, **65% of dog bites occur within the victim's home or of someone they know**.

April 6, 2024 Edmonton son of a dog owner was killed by 2 family canines.
